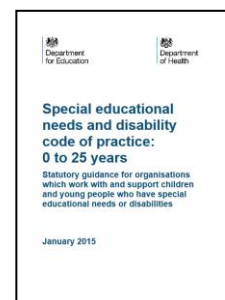
**Time:** Start at 6pm – finish no later than 9pm

#### Programme for the sessions:

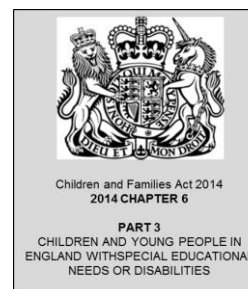
- **Session 1:** What does the Special Educational Needs Code of Practice say schools should do to meet the needs of children and young people with SEN ?
